This year's Round the Bay race sponsored by DRS Technologies proved to be among one of the fastest on record. Seven spinnaker and four non-spinnaker boats started in wind conditions varying from 1 to 6 knots which made for some interesting starts. One of the more noteworthy was Diamond which was pushed over the line early by Kahlua and then had the race committee ducking her bowsprit on the restart. The wind eventually filled in from the Southwest in the 10 to 15 knot range which made for a great run down the bay and a beat back.

The Non-spinnaker fleet was lead across the finish line by Beattie Purcell on Tango. Tom Whittemore came in second on Whits End followed by Dave Lauderbaugh on Vixen and then Paul LaRoux on Trixie. In the spinnaker fleet there was a very close finish with the first four boats finishing within 4 minutes of each other. First place and line honors went to a team of five intrepid teenagers from the Fort Walton Yacht Club led by Alex Johnson on Shinola a Sonar 23. Believe me these guys and gal knew there s...t from Shinola. Second place went to Lenny Thomas on Cantankerous followed by Pandemonium (Bill Deming), Kahlua (Mickey Duvall), Head High (Chad Knapple), Maverick (Bob Hutchinson), and Diamond (Brett Hinley).
