A 10.1 mile course was set up around government marks but the race committee made a great decision to implement the shortened course provision resulting in a 7.3 mile course. It was especially welcomed by the crew of Pandemonium as the end of the traveler track came off jibing around Boggy allowing 50 ball bearings to pour out on the deck and then over the side. The traveler was finally tied down and she was able to limp across the finish line with an ill trimmed Main. Everybody had a great time with the possible exception of Mickey Duvall who had a problem finding the finish line.

Small Boat Race Results

August 23, 2009 must go down in BBSC history as one of the most perfect August days ever. Due to the northerly breeze, both the temperature and humidity have been low (for August). As is typical of a north breeze, the wind was a bit fluky with puffs in the high teens followed shortly thereafter by shifts in direction and velocity (sometimes to almost nothing). This made the racing very challenging. At one point in the race you could be ahead of the fleet and moments later you could be in last place.

Mickey Duvall did a masterful job as race committee. He was ready to start well before the 1 P.M. start time and ran all the races very efficiently so that a total of five races were

completed a couple of minutes after 3 P.M. Thanks for the great work Mickey.

The racing was very close with some finishes separated by less than .02 minutes (less than 2 seconds) based on corrected finish time. Craig Deyerle suffered a centerboard failure during the first race but soldiered on still managing to work to windward even with the failure. He withdrew after finishing the first race. For the final standings, the top three racers were separated by one point each. The overall victory goes to Kevin Wildt, whose performance just kept getting better during the day and he came away with two third-place and three first-place finishes. Good job Kevin!
