



The 2015 Viper 640 Gulf Coast Championships will be held May 2-3, 2015 at the Fort Walton Yacht Club in Fort Walton Beach, FL. Following on the heels of a successful winter series at the Sarasota Sailing Squadron, a large Viper attendance at Bacardi Miami Race Week, and just a short jaunt after Charleston Race Week, the Viper 640 continues to grow in the Southeast United States.

The Viper 640 Gulf Coast Championships are being held in conjunction with Gulf Yachting Association's "Opening Regatta", considered the kick off to the summer sailing season along the Northern Gulf Coast. The GYA Opening Regatta will be part of the GYA's Capdeville Series where member clubs across the Gulf Yachting Association send teams aboard Flying Scots to compete in this unique interclub series. Fort Walton Yacht Club received the privilege of hosting this prestigious event as FWYC long time member George Goodall recently became the Commodore of the Gulf Yachting Association for 2015.

"The Viper 640 is excited to be part of this unique event" says Craig Wilusz, Viper Liaison for the Opening Regatta. "We are expecting boats from across the Southeast, and maybe even some a bit farther away". Indiana based SAIL22 just recently acquired a brand new Viper 640 for their program and were second to register online.

Awards presented to the Viper 640 Class will be 1st through 5th overall. A special award will be presented to the "Farthest Traveled" team. The youngest sailor under 18, has a special silver plate with Viper 640 sailplane across it set aside. Michelle Lee, of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron seems to be gunning for the "Top Female Skipper" award in the Viper 640 Class by being the first registered boat. The Viper 640 Gulf Coast Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner in the Viper Class. This beautiful wooden engraved trophy will be permitted to be put on display at the winner's home club, until the next event.

Other classes eligible for the GYA Opening Regatta / Viper 640 Gulf Coast Championships include Capdeville, Flying Scot, Flying Scot Masters Class, Open Flying Scot Class, beach cat open Portsmouth multihull, Open Portsmouth Monohull, Optimist Pram, 420, Laser, Sunfish, Viper 640, VXone, and a special invitation to the MC Scow Class to attend.
