We spent the first night at the 331 bridge and enjoyed a nice dinner at Borago. We spent the next 4 nights at Shell Island enjoying the lack of crowds at this time of the year. One night we gathered on Pirates Dream and saw many shooting stars and satellites. We also talked about composting toilets since Pirates Dream had installed one. We then sailed to Port St. Joe and spent two nights in the marina so that some boats could get their holding tanks emptied but their pumpout suffered a mechanical failure.
