

Awards & Meeting JANUARY 23, 2021

The annual awards meeting was held on January 23, 2021 via zoom meeting. All bridge officers were present. There were a total of 31 participants that joined. The meeting was called to order at 6:06 by Michael Morris. There was a motion made by Patty Deming to accept minutes from the last spring meeting, Jeff Amos second. Treasurer Leslie Cooper reported the checking balance of \$5,5608.00 and BBSC membership at 74 members. Commodore Michael Morris commented that we as a club did really well with adapting to the changes the pandemic brought during the 2020 sailing season. Michael thanked the bridge members for stepping up and their hard work. Even with the pandemic there were more people on the water, more boats and our membership continues to grow.

Vice Commodore Jeff Amos said the challenge of last year was getting awards out. Rear Commodores Aleksa and Zack Kastl said the Chili Dog Contest turnout was great and about the only scheduled social event that happened in 2020 but are looking to somewhat of a normal season for 2021. PHRF Fleet Captain Tom McNally said it was a challenging year but the sailors got out and sailed. He thanked everyone for their participation and patience and is looking forward to getting back to normal somehow. Tom has a full schedule for sailing races on the BBSC website calendar and has added an interesting fun race series. Tom still needs people to sign up for race committee for the upcoming season. Tom has also added zoom seminars, previous Sailor of the Year winners Mark Hunter and Mickey Duvall have shared their racing knowledge. Tom would like to modify racing times. The spring and fall races will begin at the same time but summer races will begin in the late afternoon or early evening. Tom asked if anyone is interested in racing to please contact him to get on Group Me. It's been the most effective way the club communicates for meetings or changes in scheduled calendar events. The BBSC calendar has been updated with all racing information, skipper meetings, race results, etc.

Small Boat Fleet Captain Ramsty Siberski said 2020 was fantastic and the pandemic didn't affect small boat racing. He had 35 sailors sail in two divisions in 9 different events. Ramsty needs people to sign up to be race committee for 2021 and has 10 races planned. He would like to hold a weekend regatta, a Saturday and Sunday race and a novelty race where boats start from the beach. Newsletter Editor Patty Deming said she will be mailing out membership cards this week as well as those that continue to renew. Michael Morris thanked Patty for the extra ways she helped the club, setting up PayPal for sailors to pay for racing events and BBSC shirts and updating the BBSC website and calendar.

Quartermaster Brenda Crabbe said she has ordered shirts that were back ordered. Brenda will take shirts to the shipstore for pick up and will email or call people to let them know they are there. Michael Morris thanked Brenda for the work she did on selecting different options on shirts last year and said he appreciated everything she did.
