## PHRF FLEET CAPTAIN REPORT

### 2021 Commodore's Cup

The Commodore's Cup was contested in three classes, and included Round the Bay West, Round the Bay East, Sailfest and Grand Finale.

In the Spinnaker Class, Mark Hunter and his crew on Epiphany sailed a consistent series to edge Roy Byrd and Co. on Pier Pressure.

The X-Class was new this year, and featured special handicapping based on previous race results. Giesla and Bill Redinger on Humdinger topped the standings in a class that attracted and many as 10 boats to the starting line.

The Non-spinnaker Class was won by Curtis Duvall in Parley.

### 2021 Sailor of the Year

The Sailor of the Year competition was open to all members. Sailors scored points anytime they competed in any of the 21 PHRF and Small Boat race days, from Round the Bay West, to Black Friday, whether as skipper or crew. This year 19 of the 21 scheduled races were held, and the best 13 scores counted toward Sailor of the Year.

The competition raged all year long between Ned, Roy, Grover, Curtis, Zack and Tom in both Small Boats and PHRF. In the end, only five points separated first and second, and a single point separated third and fourth. The top five are as follows:

1. Tom McNally (sailing on SnapDragon and Rosie)
2. Zack Kastl (sailing on Epiphany and 38 Special)
3. Curtis Duvall (sailing on Parley and Illegal Smile)
4. Grover Niles (sailing on Shenanigan and Bad Man)
5. Roy Byrd (sailing on Pier Pressure and JY15)
