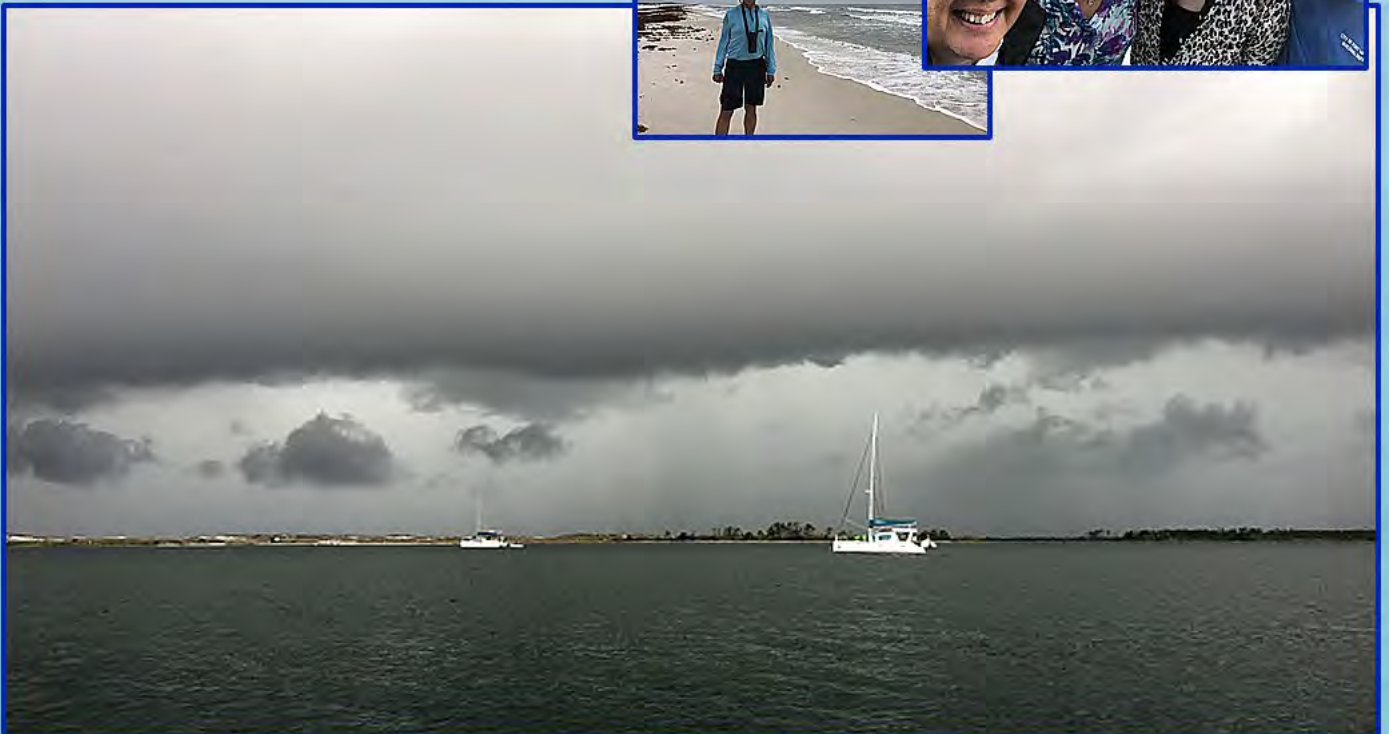

Hola Intrepid Sailors,

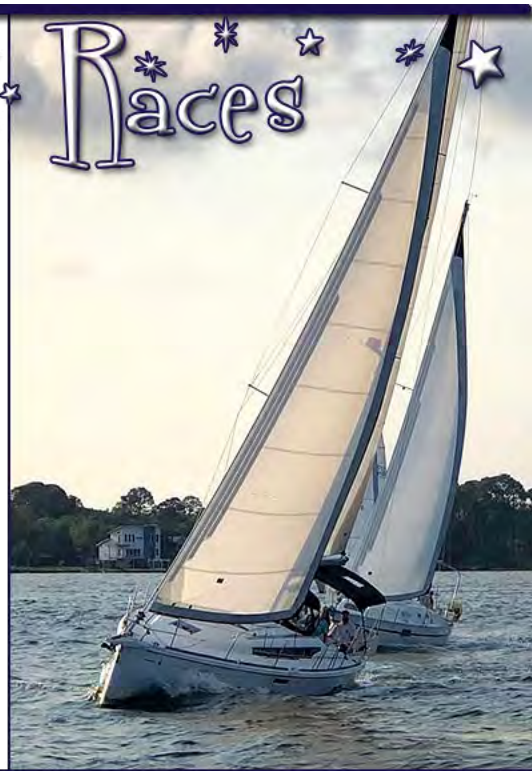
16 boats plied the waters last week in our Wednesday Night Fun Race. PER DIEM was the race committee.
