- RULES** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- CLASSES** All boats will compete as a single class. At least three (3) boats from each club must compete to constitute a valid regatta.
- ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY** Each boat must have a valid PHRF certificate.
- FEES** The entry fee is \$30 per boat, which includes food for Skipper and two (2) mates after the races. Additional meal tickets are \$7 each.
- SCHEDULE**  
Saturday, September 12, 2015  
10:00 – 11:00 Registration  
11:00 Skippers meeting  
12:00 First Warning
- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** The sailing instructions will be available at registration.
- VENUE** Regatta headquarters will be the Fort Walton Yacht Club.
- COURSES** The courses will be announced at the Skippers meeting. The racing area will be located on the waters of Choctawhatchee Bay. Two races are planned: a windward/leeward course and a distance course utilizing government marks.
- SCORING** The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply using the PHRF ToT rating system. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta. Scoring will be by club team with team size determined by the club with the fewer number of boats. Rule A2 is changed so that a team series score shall be the total of her individual boat scores. No score shall be excluded.
- PRIZES** The winning team will be awarded the Bay Challenge Trophy.
- LIABILITY** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither Fort Walton Yacht Club nor Bluewater Bay Sailing Club will accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with the regatta.
