RULES The race will be governed by the current 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as altered by the Sailing Instructions. ELIGIBILITY All boats with a PHRF or ORA rating (and all sailors) are welcome at this event. If you don't have one of these ratings, we can provide a temporary one for you so you can race while you apply for one yourself. We'll even help you with your application. Mark Hunter might even pay for it. CLASSES Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, X-Class REGISTRATION Please pre-register by sending an email (or GroupMe post) to small-boat-captain@bbsc.com (I fixed the address this time, should work). If you have sailed with us before, send me the boat name and skipper's name. If you haven't sailed with us, send your boat name, boat make/model/length, skipper's name, sail number, PHRF/ORA rating, and competition class. Note: / have experienced random events where emails to that address go to "spam." If you don't hear from me in 1-2 days, please shoot me a text to the number below, and I'll check my spam folder. FEES	<b>**This is different than past years**.</b> Race fee is \$20 Per Boat, or a one-time payment of \$150 for the entire season of racing. A Pay-Pal link on the BBSC webpage is available. T- Shirts, food will be available for purchase for you and your crew. You will be able to purchase food tickets and t-shirt orders at the skipper's meeting, and the day of the race.
SAILING INSTRUCTIONS	Sailing instructions will be delivered by email and linked by Group Me prior to the skipper's meeting.
RACING VENUE	The racing area will be the waters of Rocky Bayou, and Choctawhatchee Bay.
COURSE	To be described in the sailing instructions, and/or as modified at the skipper's meeting. Expect a 1 ish mile windward/leeward course for Spin & Non-Spin, and government mark course for X- Class.
SCORING	We will use the old PHRF ratings for scoring for Commodore's cup. We will provide the results for ORA for fun, and we'll keep doing that all year.
AWARDS	Awards will be announced and presented on the dock on the water-side of Schooner's at the time stated above.
