	X-Class – For Cruisers or others. Special handicapping based on previous race results, or best information available. No equipment restrictions.

REGATTA SITE	The regatta headquarters will be at the Bluewater Bay Marina.
RACING AREA	The racing area will be located on the waters of Choctawhatchee Bay West of the Mid-Bay Bridge.
COURSES	Course will be established using Government and club marks, with a length of approximately 10 - 12 miles.



SCORING	Finish position determines placing. PHRF or X-rating will be used to assign start time. Bermuda Start.
